## **PRINCIPALS'S COMPASS CHALLENGE (K-5)**

### **December 23 – April 22**

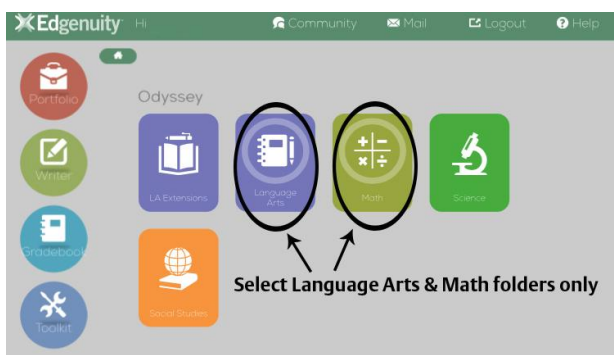
All students have recently taken their 2<sup>nd</sup> Round of MAP (Measurement of Academic Progress) testing in Reading and Math. These tests help assess your child's ability levels. The information gathered helps target areas of strength and deficiency in your child's education. MAP scores are used to develop an individualized learning path in a web-based program called Compass Learning. It's a personalized learning program that asks questions based on each child's instructional level.

### **THE CHALLENGE**

- We are encouraging our students to use Compass whenever they can (school, home, etc.). If they complete the challenge prizes can be earned (see below). Dates of the Challenge: Dec. 23-April 22

### **THE REQUIREMENTS**

- To complete at least 8 quizzes total from the Language Arts and Math folders in Compass. This entails the student to go through learning lessons followed by a quiz. Length and number of lessons vary.
- Quizzes must have a 70% or higher grade/accuracy. A report can be run for updates, under the "Reports" button.
- A balance between these two folders is a requirement (all 8 quizzes can't be from the Math folder).



### **THE REWARD**

- Students who complete at least 8 quizzes with 70% accuracy will receive a Royalview Sling Bag!
- Top student in each grade will earn an electronic device such as a tablet or Chrome book.
- Prizes will be handed out in May to all those who participated and completed the Challenge.

### **HOW TO ACCESS THE PROGRAM**

- Login to [www.weschools.org](http://www.weschools.org). Under "Students" select "Compass".
- Students have their personalized logins. Login information is available from their teacher.
- A report can be run by going to "Portfolio/Reports". Select subject and date range. A report will come up showing lessons completed and their quiz scores.
