Last year we purchased a new popcorn machine. We are also looking to replace some of our folding tables. Funds from Fun Run are used for these types of purchases.
- c. Spirit wear-We have a new spirit wear company. The store is available online all year. The first sale is a Flash Sale. These will be the cheapest prices of the year. All items in the Flash Sale are produced in a bulk order. Then they are shipped to the school so there is no shipping cost. Items purchased individually after the Flash Sale have a shipping cost of \$8.99 and they are shipped directly to your home.
- d. Membership-All PTA members is online this year. The information was in the packet sent home last week. The information is also on the PTA website. Room parents for parties must be a PTA member. There will be an early bird raffle at our October meeting for gift cards. We will also have a membership raffle at our PTA meeting in November.
