Fundraising Goals = \$20K

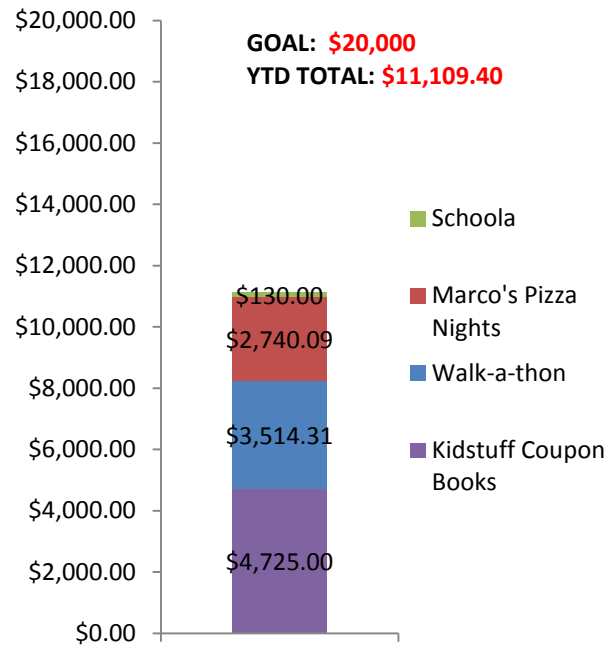
